Provide scaffolds such as concept maps so students can identify the critical aspects of the problem, question or issue and the relationships impacting it. • Activate background knowledge and assumptions. Provide prompts to help students identify the background knowledge and assumptions they bring to the situation • Access to expert knowledge. Have students contact experts to help them discern the more salient aspects and interrelationships of the problem, question or issue • Time. Expect that this will take time as the deeper one understands the problem, question or issue the less likely one is to jump to conclusions
